

## UAB Hazardous Waste Satellite Accumulation Area Self - Inspection Checklist

- Does each container used for onsite accumulation of hazardous waste have a label identifying its contents? **40 CFR 262.34(a)(3)** ([http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml\\_00/Title\\_40/40cfr262\\_00.html](http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml_00/Title_40/40cfr262_00.html))
- Is the hazardous waste container labeled as to the composition and physical state (liquid or solid) of the hazardous waste identified?
- Are boxed containers of chemicals for removal properly segregated, packed and manifested?
- Is there appropriate secondary containment for bulk waste liquids? (over 5 gallons per container)
- Are Hazardous waste containers always kept closed when not in use? **40 CFR 265.173(a)** ([http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml\\_00/Title\\_40/40cfr265\\_00.html](http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml_00/Title_40/40cfr265_00.html) )
- Is the volume of waste at or near any point of generation, in one room, less than 55 gallons of hazardous waste or one quart for acutely hazardous waste or one quart of extremely hazardous waste? **40 CFR 262.34** ([http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml\\_00/Title\\_40/40cfr262\\_00.html](http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml_00/Title_40/40cfr262_00.html))
- Are containers compatible with contents? **40 CFR 265.172** ([http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml\\_00/Title\\_40/40cfr265\\_00.html](http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml_00/Title_40/40cfr265_00.html) )
- Are containers in good condition and otherwise free from leaks and corrosion? **40 CFR 265.171** ([http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml\\_00/Title\\_40/40cfr265\\_00.html](http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml_00/Title_40/40cfr265_00.html) )
- Have all individuals handling or generating hazardous received their annual training in accordance with UAB requirements? New workers must be trained within 6 months of hire. Contact the Department of Occupational Health and Safety at 924-2487 for more information. **40 CFR 262.34(a)(4)** ([http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml\\_00/Title\\_40/40cfr262\\_00.html](http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml_00/Title_40/40cfr262_00.html))
- Has the waste been characterized? This information is submitted to the HMF Manager upon request. This file must be updated annually or when the waste stream changes. **40 CFR 268.7** ([http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml\\_00/Title\\_40/40cfr268\\_00.html](http://www.access.gpo.gov/nara/cfr/cfrhtml_00/Title_40/40cfr268_00.html) )
- Does the laboratory have a current Chemical Hygiene Plan?
- Does the laboratory have a copy of the Chemical Safety and Waste Management Manual?
- Is the following emergency information present in the laboratory?
  - a. Name and Telephone number of the emergency contact.
  - b. Location of the nearest fire extinguishers
  - c. Location of spill control materials
  - d. Location of fire alarm
